Cholesterol Help for Kids and their Families

ANN LIEBISKIND, M.D.

Pediatric and Adult Lipidologist, Dr. Ann Liebeskind, is the owner of Mobile Health Team, a private lipids practice in Wauwatosa and Neenah, Wis., and the founder of Homework for Health, an online teaching resource to help healthcare practitioners, educators and families manage cholesterol. Considered an innovator in her field, Liebeskind began her career in 2003 as one of the first diplomats of the American Board of Clinical Lipidology.

Dr. Liebeskind is a Faculty Member of the National Lipid Association and an expert in Familial Hypercholesterolemia, a genetic cholesterol disease. In 2015, she wrote “Adventures in Cholesterol”, a 28-page graphic novel created to empower children and parents in managing their cholesterol.

In 2014, Dr. Liebeskind was named a regional expert in pediatric obesity, serving as a designated Childhood Obesity Advisor for Continuing Health (COACH) for the American Academy of Pediatrics.

In 2006, while working for Affinity Health System in Appleton, WI, Dr. Liebeskind launched the first combined pediatric and adult lipids clinic in Northeast Wisconsin. While at Affinity, she collaborated with colleagues at Mayo Clinic to create COURAGE, a preventive program to fight heart disease, now offered by Network Health Plan.

In 2008, Liebeskind worked with a team of doctors to bring the first LDL Apheresis program to Northeast Wisconsin.

In 2013, she launched Mobile Health Team, a private Lipidology practice where she treats pediatric and adult patients with cholesterol problems through in-person and tele-health (online video visits).

Dr. Liebeskind is an expert in cholesterol and has a strong interest in technology. Using both of these passions, she has developed tools for kids and families to fostering healthy lifestyles. By providing better tools and support, Liebeskind hopes to help patients improve their cholesterol and achieve healthier futures.

Dr. Liebeskind, a Wisconsin native, holds board certifications in Internal Medicine and Pediatrics. She is a graduate of the University of Wisconsin Medical School and completed her internship and residency at the University of Kentucky Hospital. She is married with two sons.
